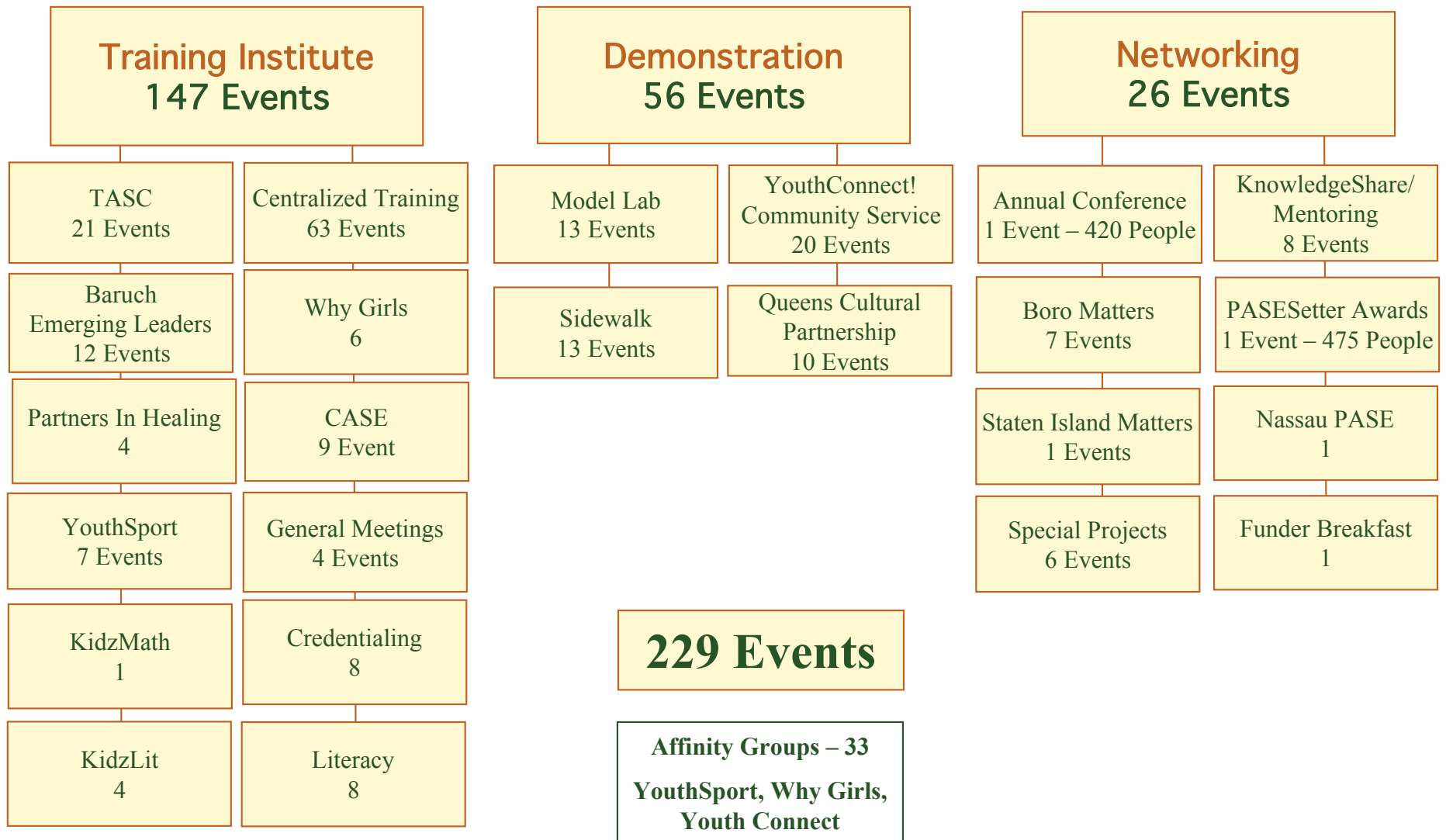

What Events Did PASE Offer Between January 2003 – December 2003?

- 229 Events
 - ✓ 147 Training Events (Centralized, TASC, Baruch, Forums, etc.)
 - ✓ 56 Demonstration Project-Related Events (Lab, Sidewalks, Youth Connect)
 - ✓ 26 Networking Events (Conference, Symposium, PASEsetter Awards, Boro Matters)
- Average of 5 events per week

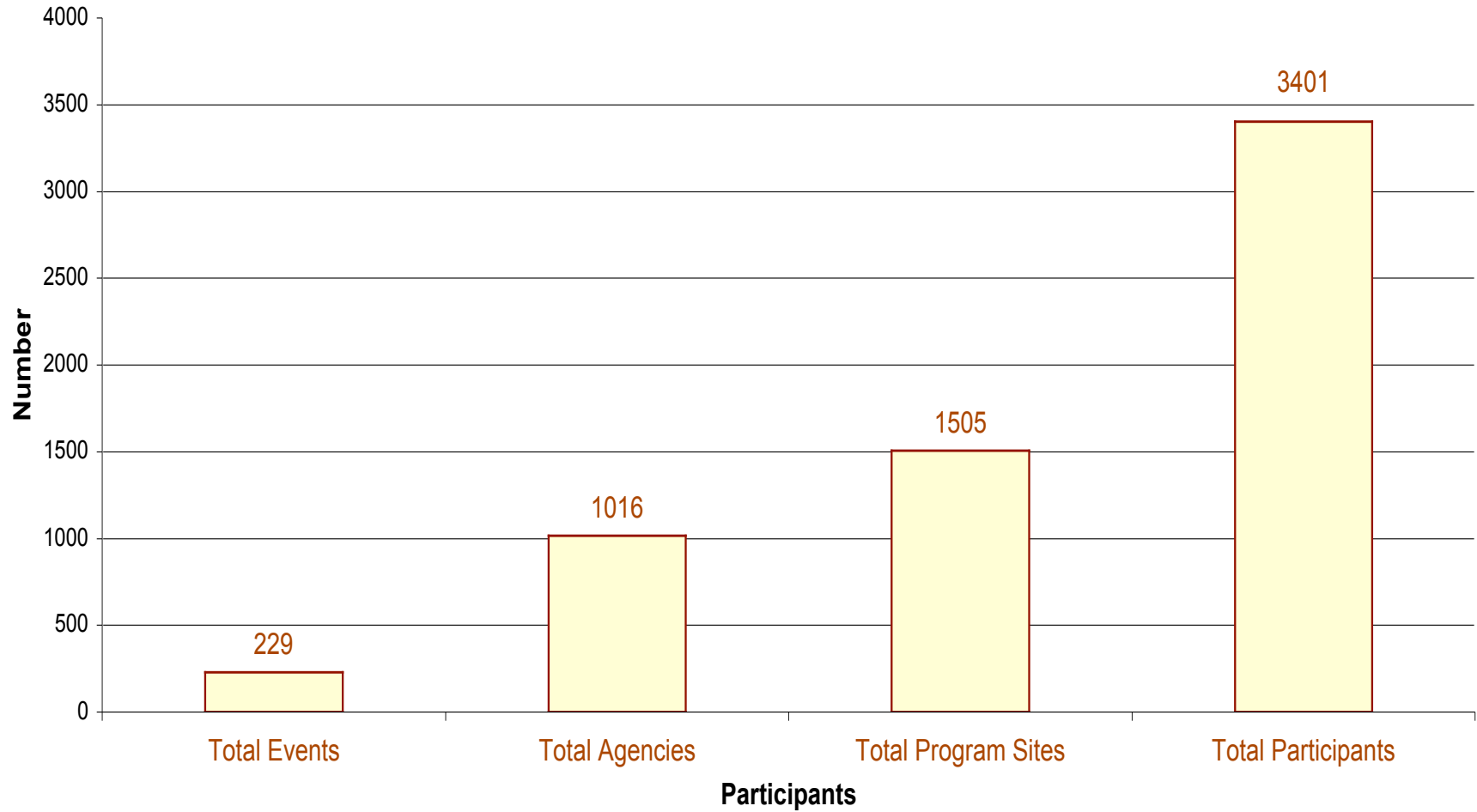


How Many Agencies and Individuals Participated in PASE Events?

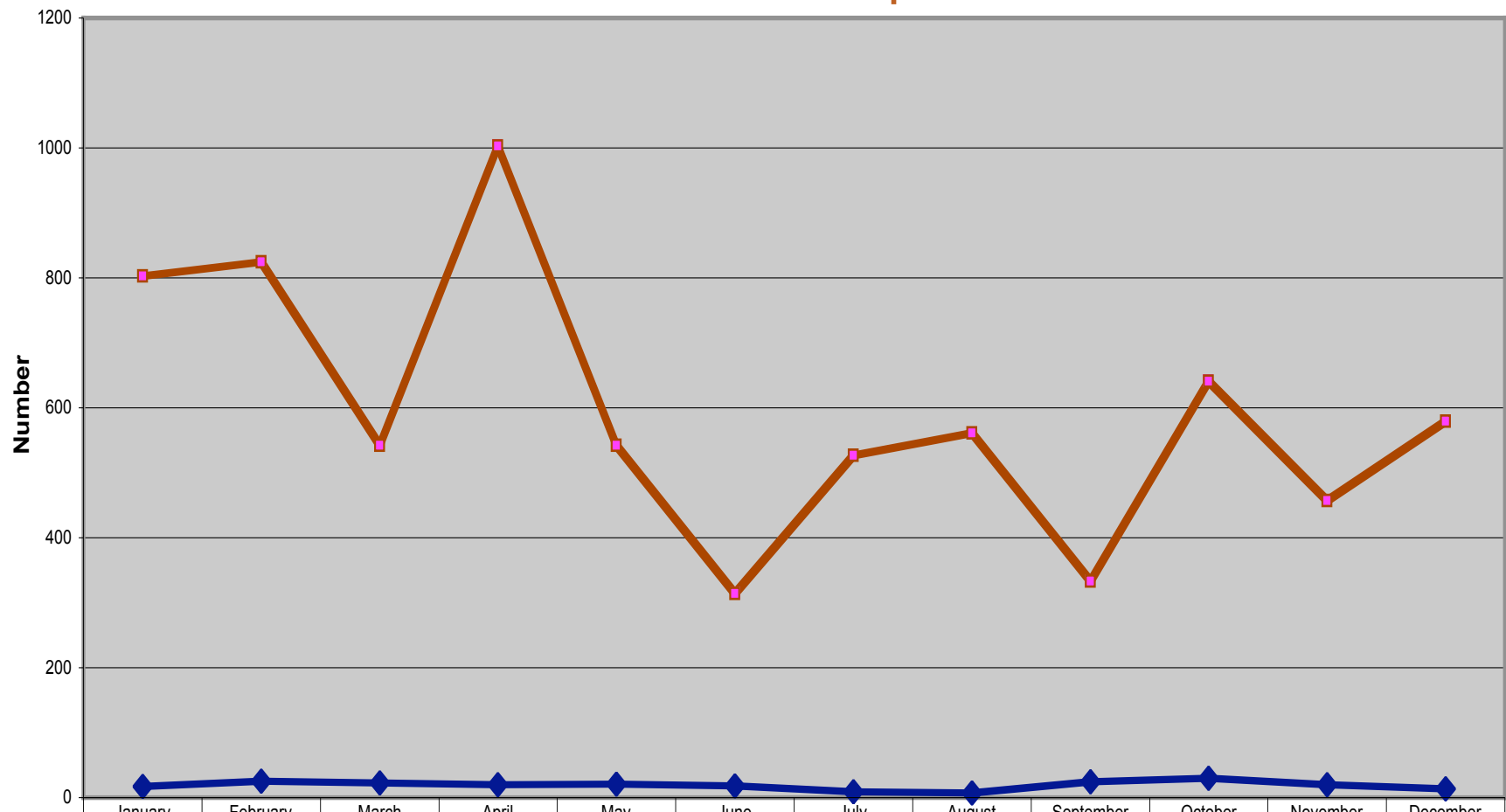

Highlights of Participation in PASE Events

- Average Size of General Meetings – 172 Individuals, 103 Agencies
- Average Size of Centralized Training Workshops – 20 Individuals, 15 Agencies
- Actual Size of Annual Conference – 420 Individuals, 168 Agencies
- Actual Size of PASEsetter Awards – 475 Individuals, 143 Agencies

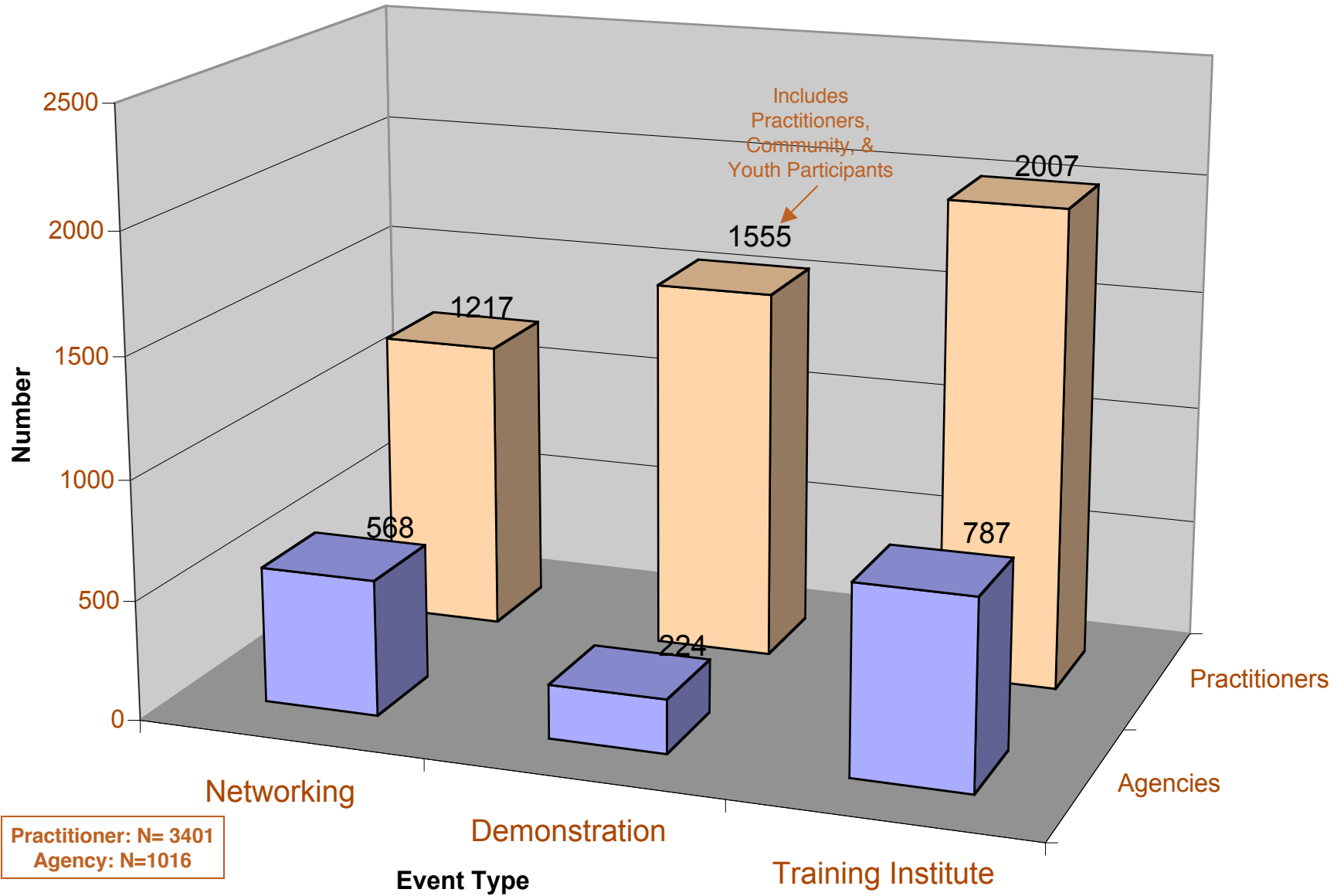
Number of Events and Participants Per Month



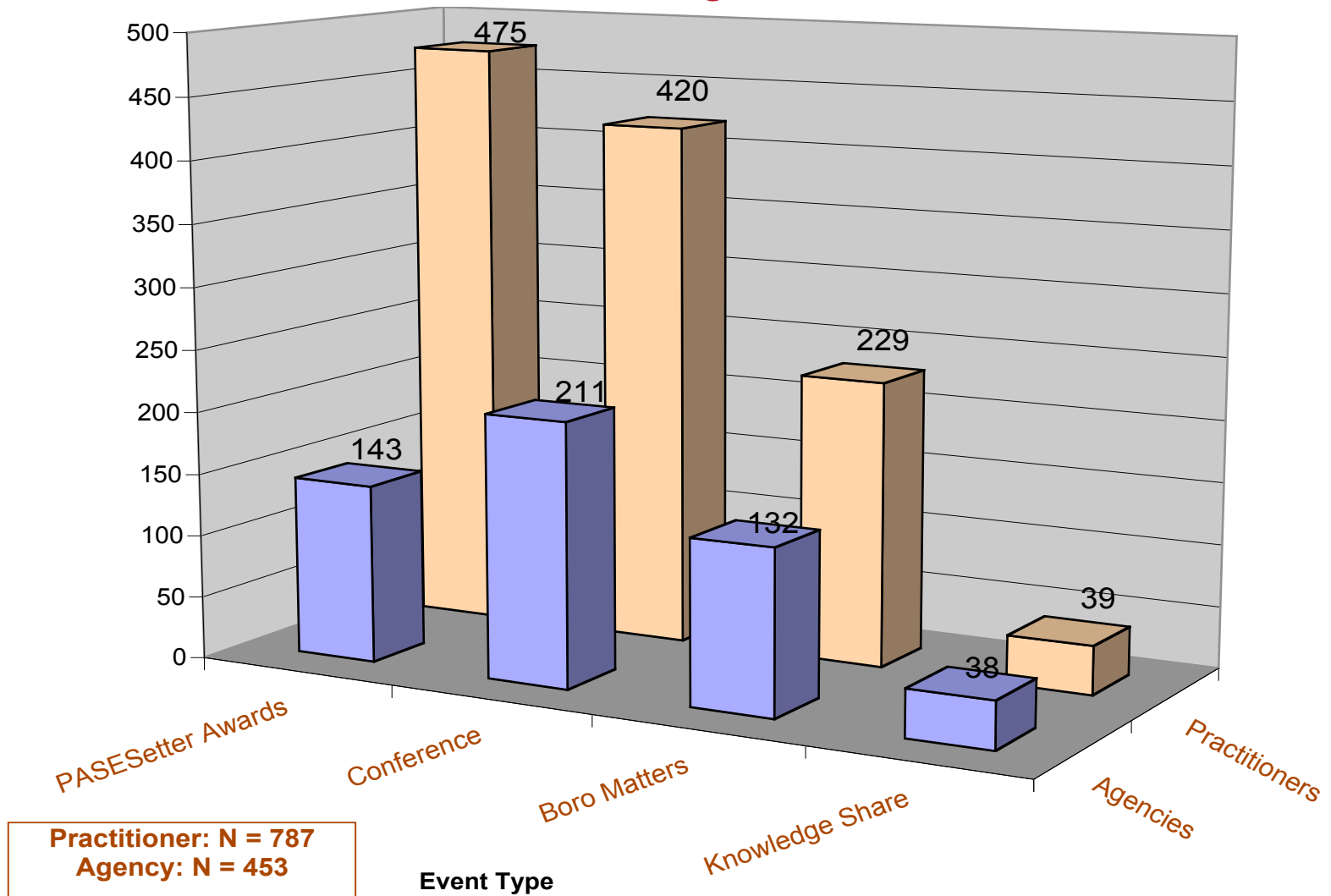

Number of Different Participants in PASE Events

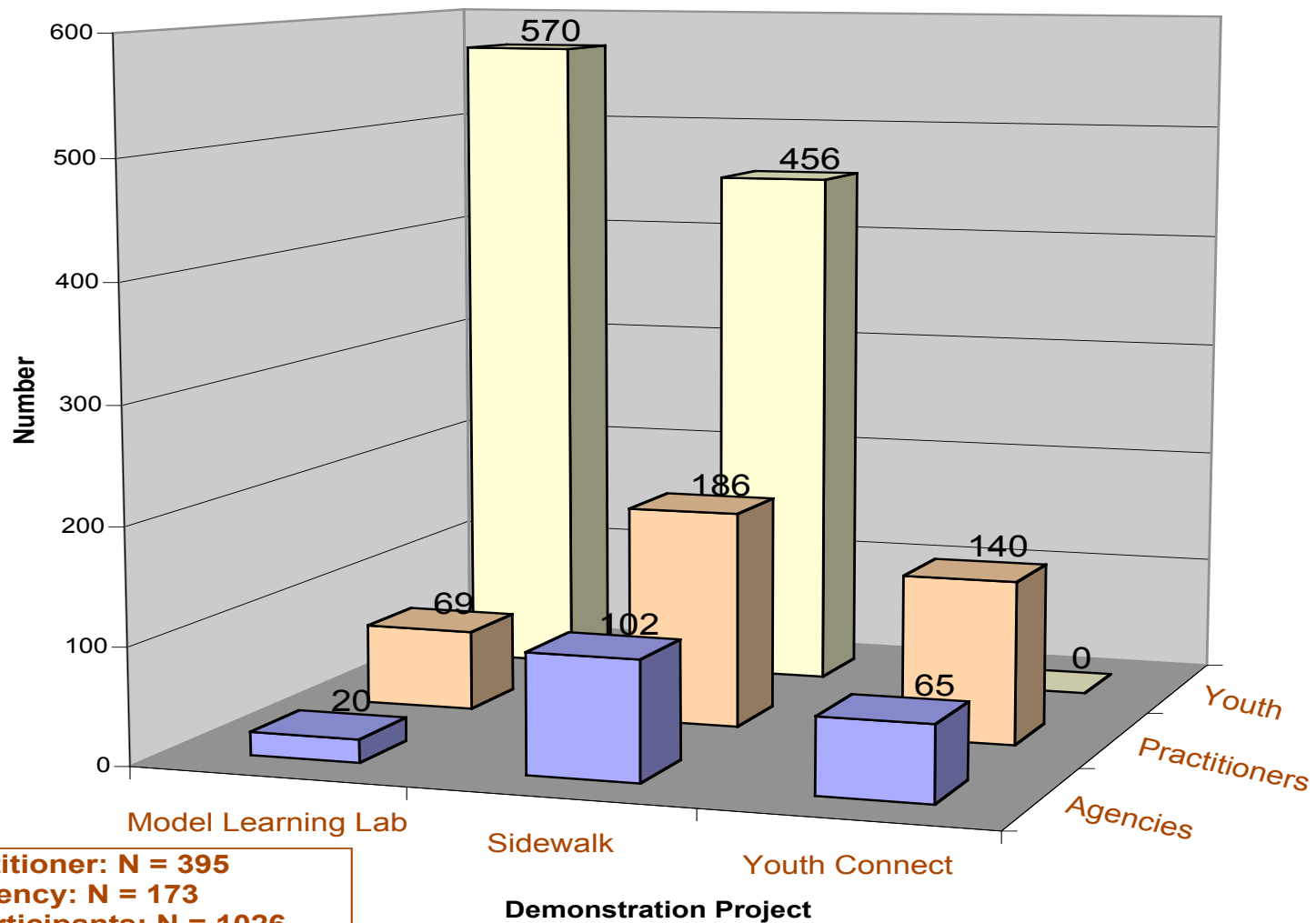


Evaluation Question #2 Number of Different Participants in 26 Networking Events

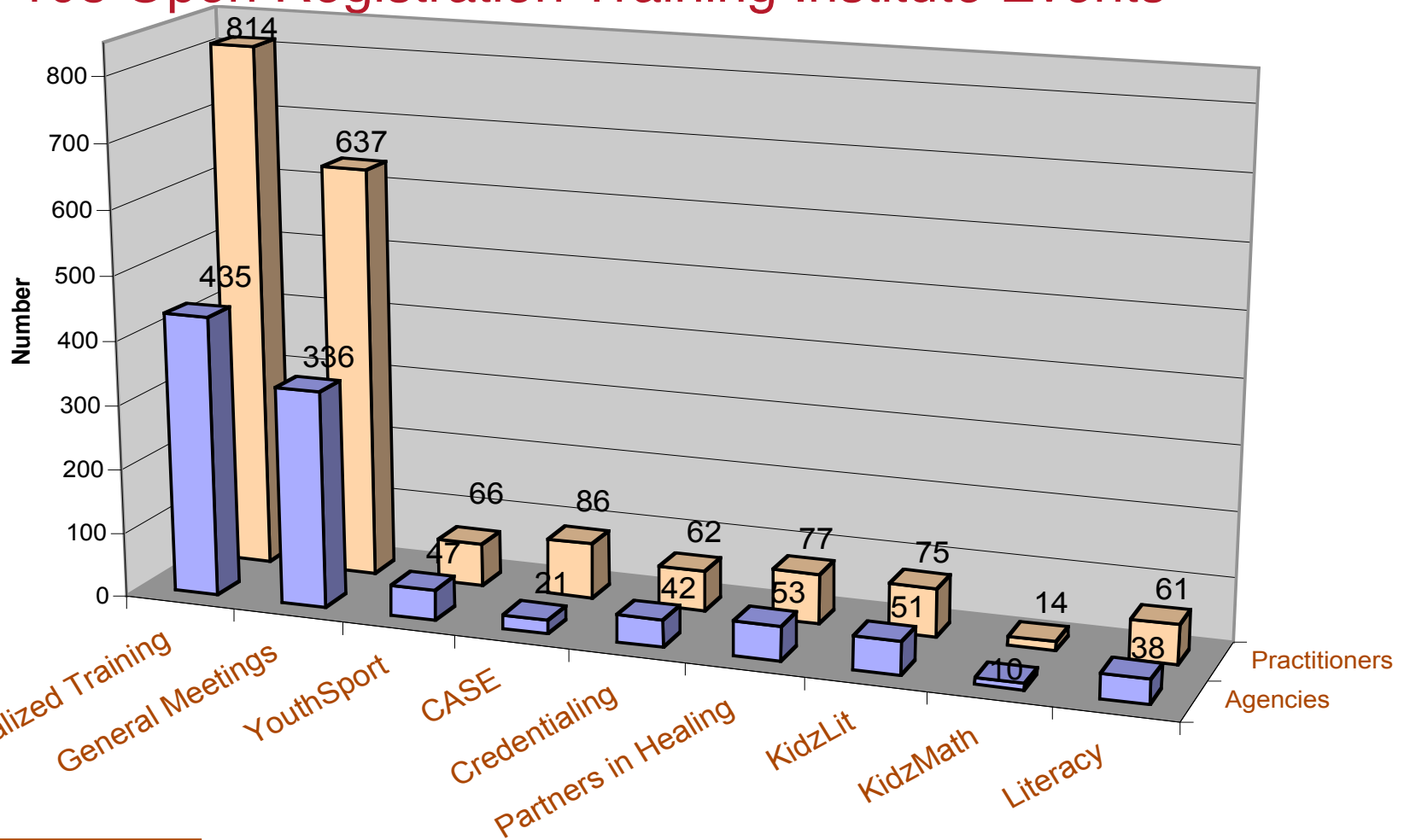
Number of Different Participants in 56 Demonstration Project-Related Events

Number of Different Participants in 108 Open Registration Training Institute Events

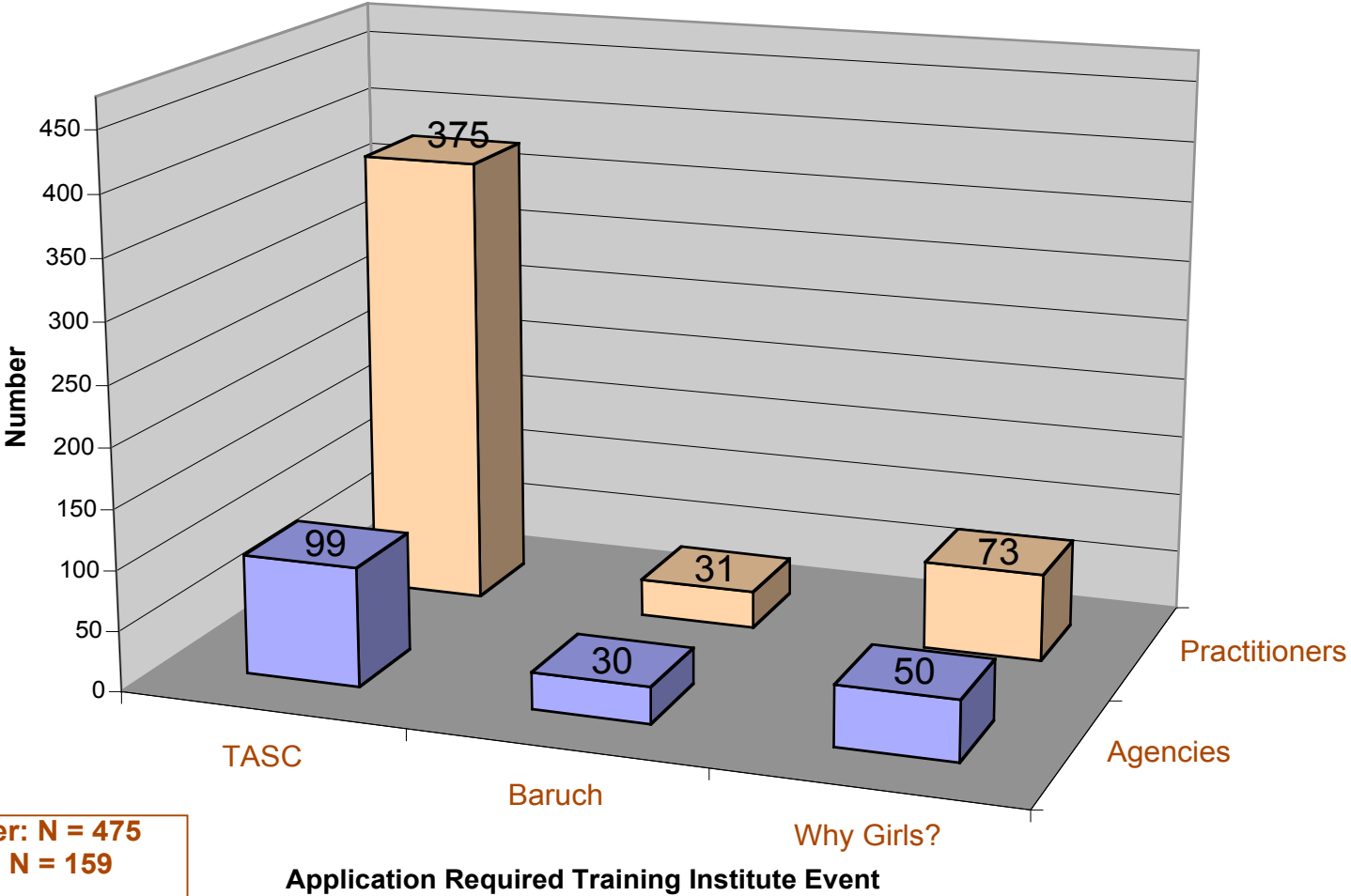

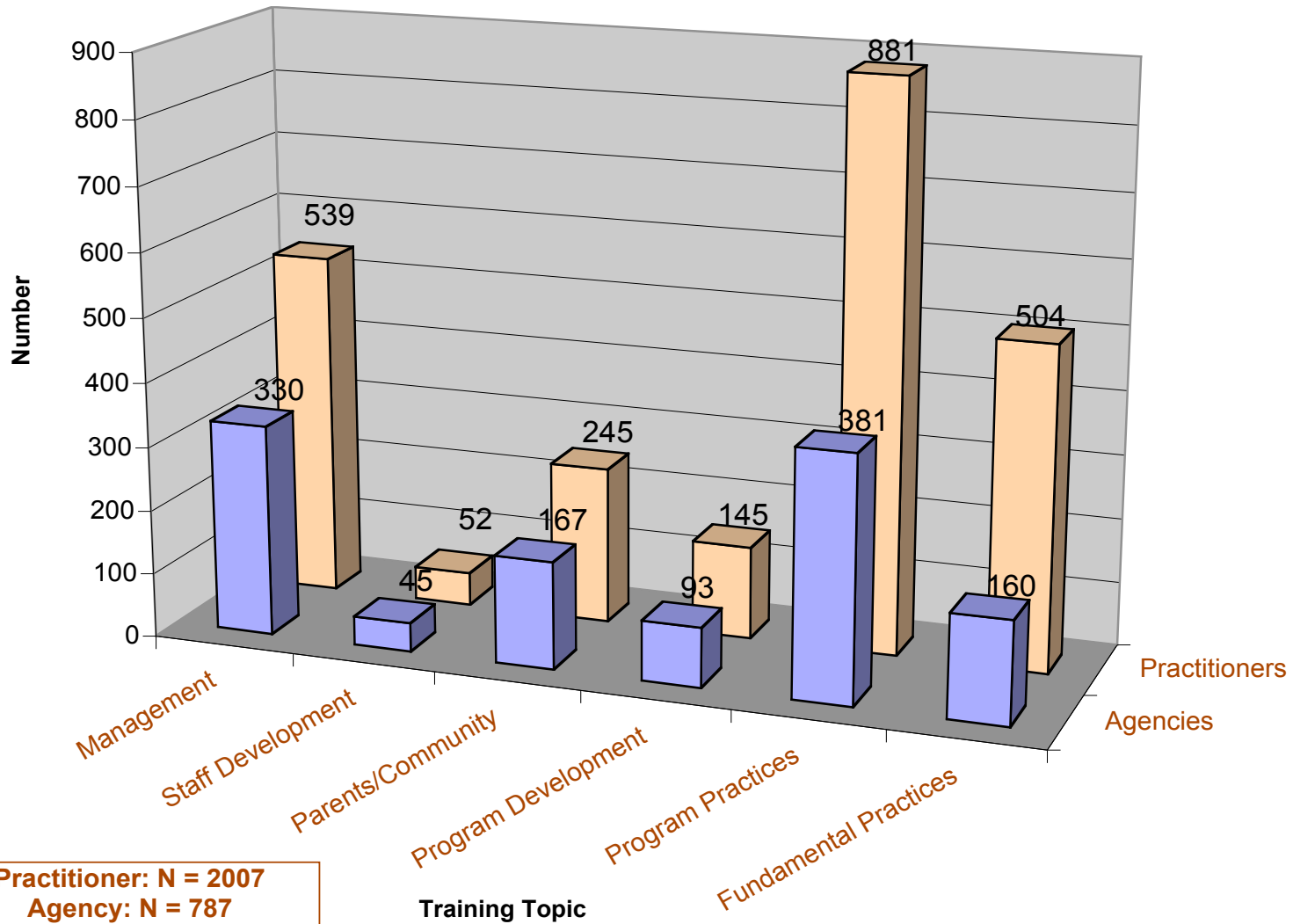

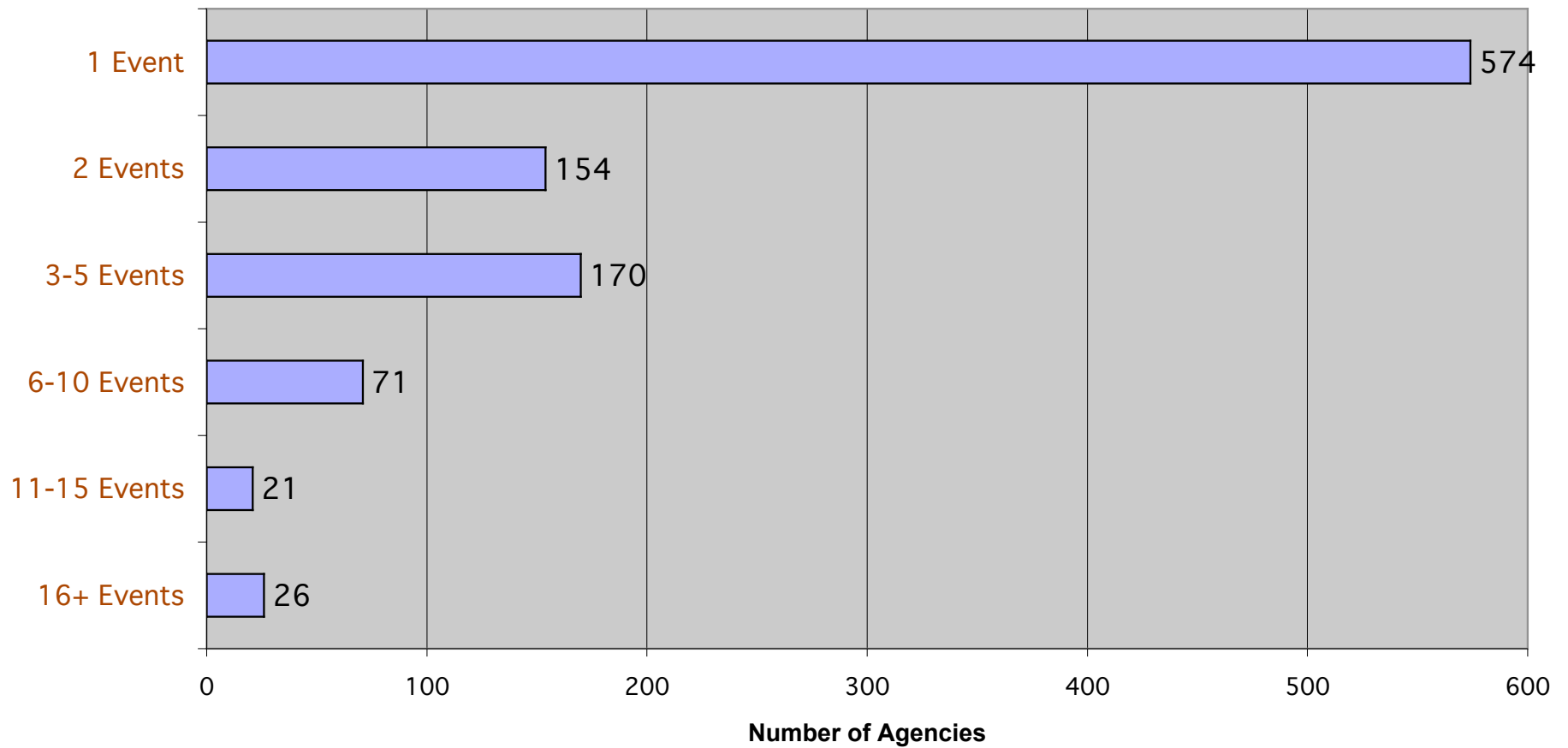
Number of Different Participants in 38 Application-Required/Closed Training Institute Events



Evaluation Question #2 Number of Participants In 6 Different Types of Training Institute Workshops



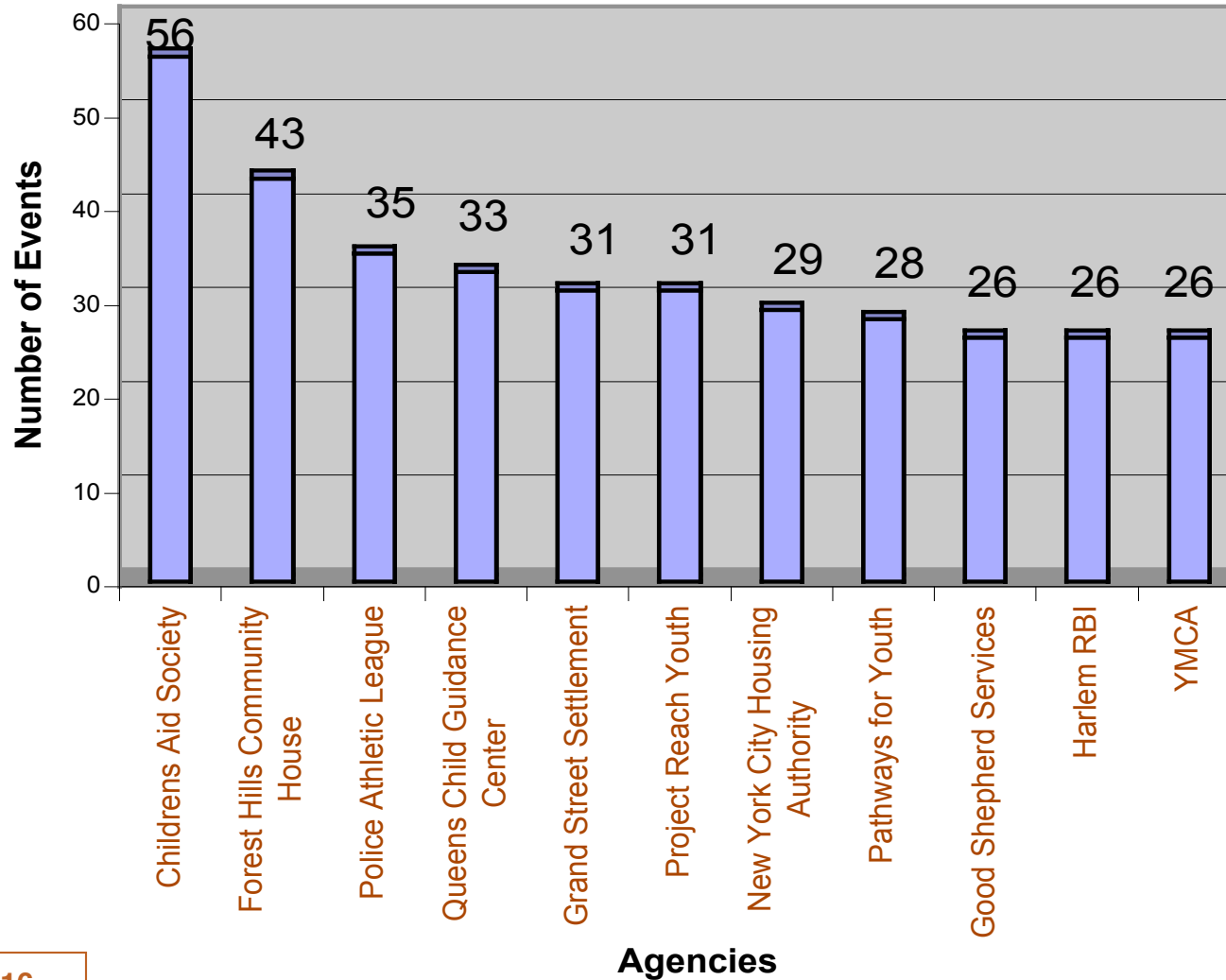
How Often Did Agencies Participate in PASE Events?

Top 10 Participating Agencies In PASE Events

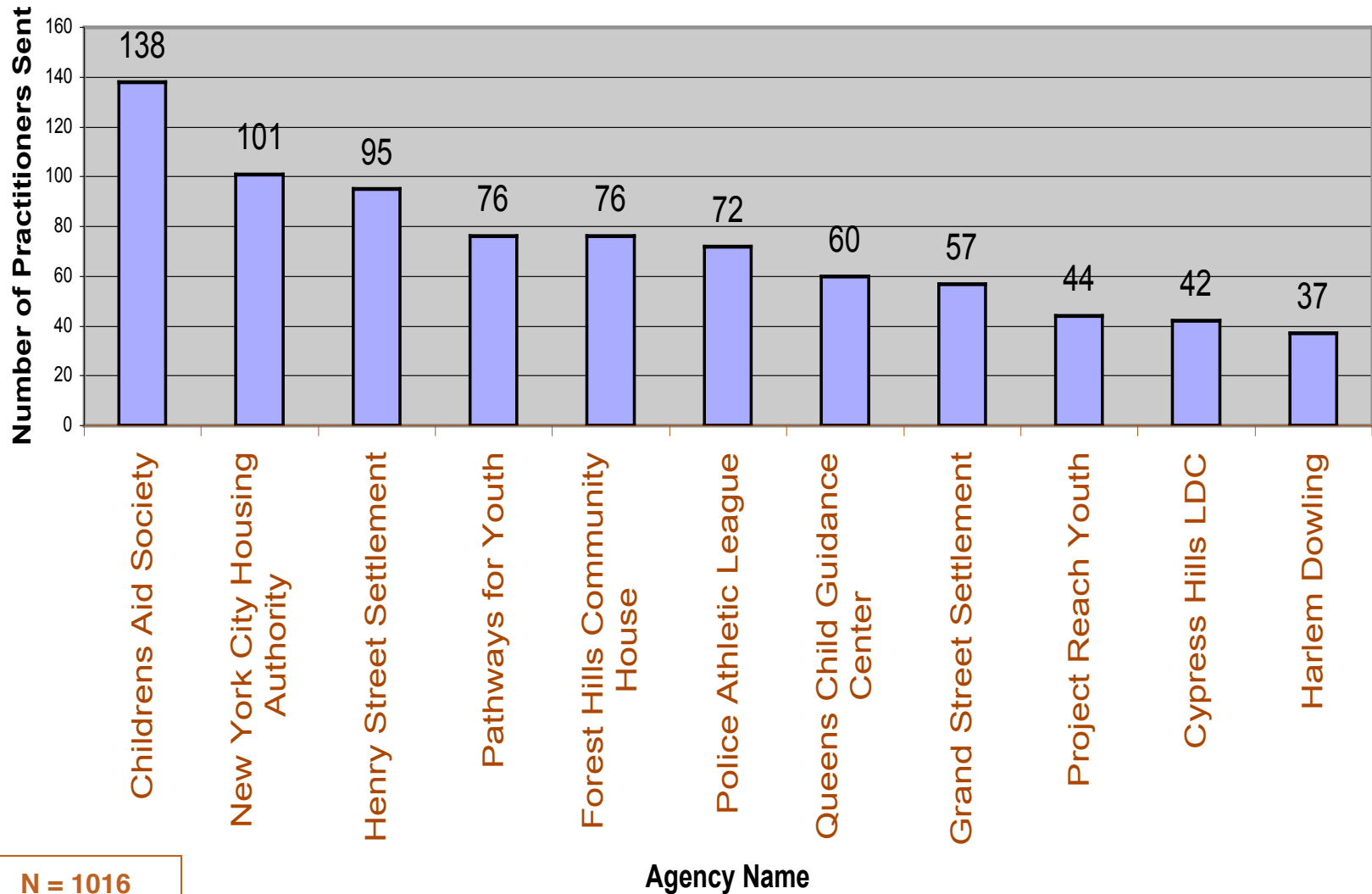
Depth of Reach – How Often Were Agencies Represented at Events?

Top 11 Participating Agencies In PASE Events

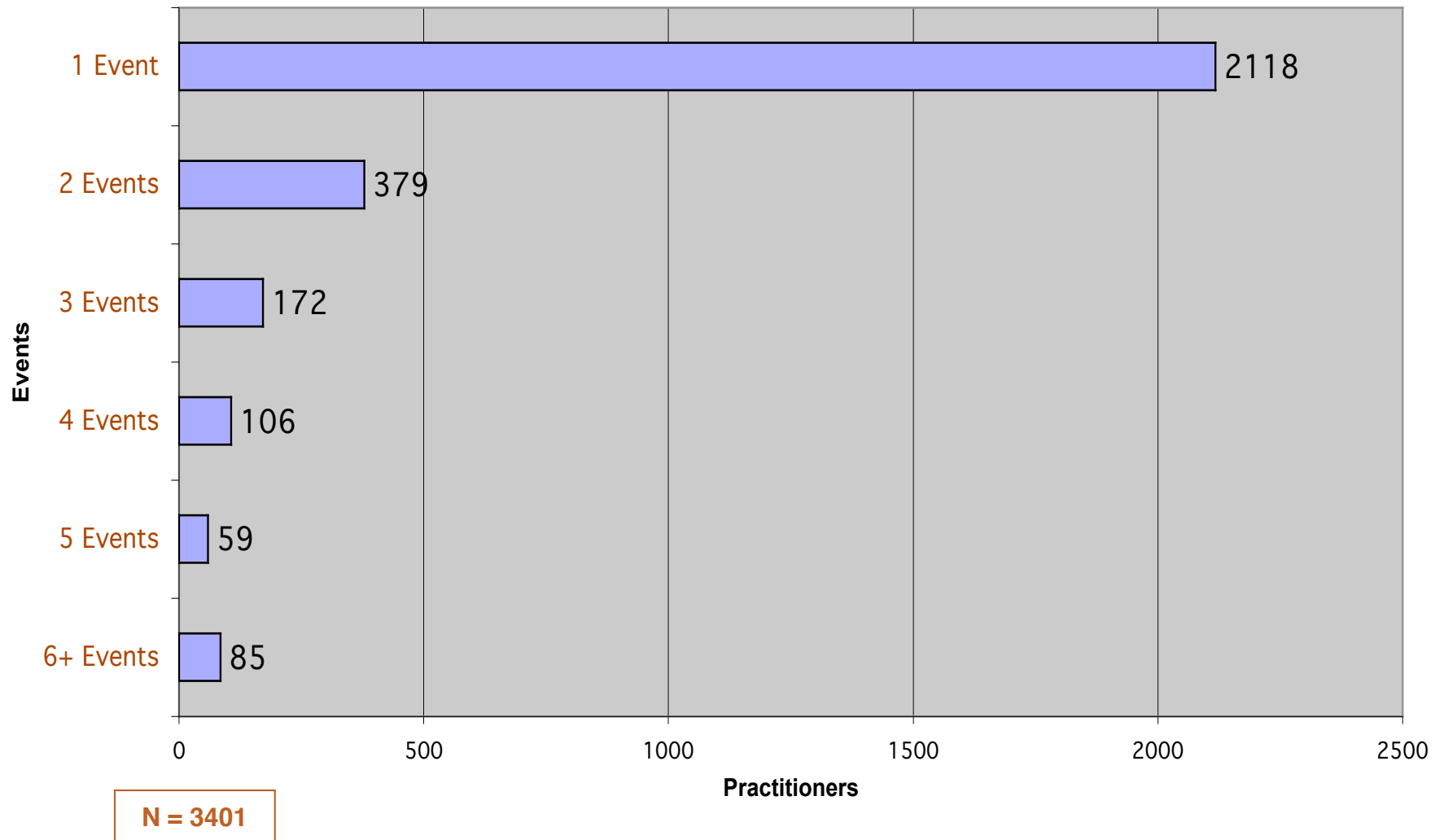
Breadth of Reach – Which Agencies Sent the Most Representatives?



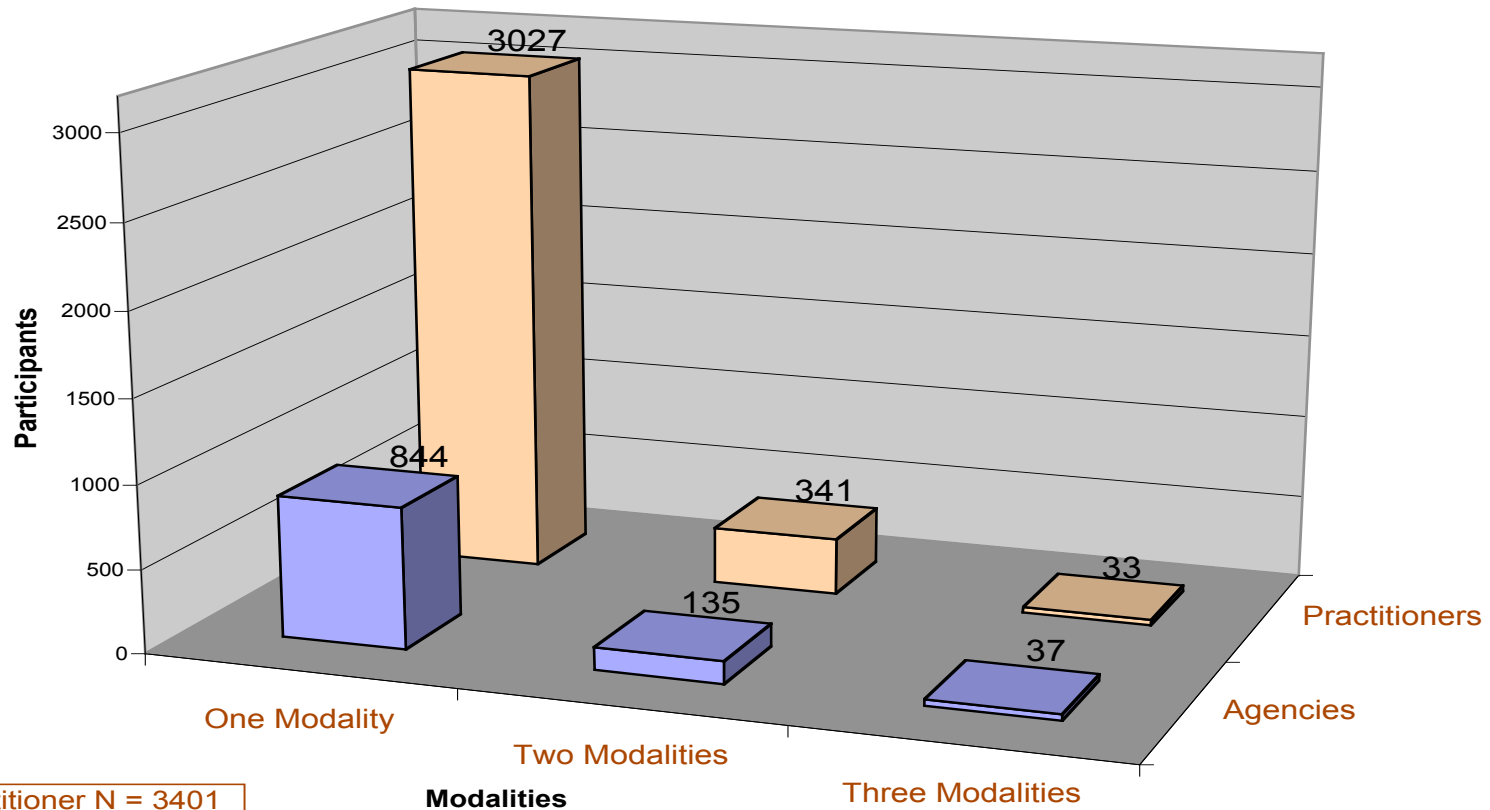

Next Steps in Evaluation

- Determine how many individuals are completing full series of foundational trainings and/or advanced trainings;
- Assess points of entry and patterns of use for individuals and agencies;
- Through post-participation surveys after some time has passed, ask trainees and their supervisors how they perceive the value of their training and what recommendations they have for further training;
- Through focus group discussions, individual interviews, and agency case studies, capture effective ways that agencies support trainee efforts to put newly learned skills into practice.
